



BAC Resolution No. R-003-20

BAC RESOLUTION ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE MODES OF PROCUREMENT

WHEREAS, during the 34th Regular BAC Goods Meeting dated 7 December 2020 and 32nd Regular BAC Infrastructure Meeting dated 9 December 2020, various end-users requested for Alternative Modes of Procurement under FC 9151017;

WHEREAS, the end-users justified the urgency of the procurement of the items, promotes efficiency and economy, and also the utilization of funds;

WHEREAS, the BAC recommended Alternative Mode of Procurement under Sec 52.1(b) Shopping, Negotiated Procurement- Sec. 53.9 Small Value Procurement (NP-SVP), and Sec. 50 Direct-Contracting;

WHEREAS, Section 48 (Alternative Methods) of Rule XVI – Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, Otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, states among others, that:

“Subject to the prior approval by the Head of the Procuring Entity and whenever justified by the conditions provided in this Act, the Procuring Entity may, in order to promote economy and efficiency, resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided in this Rule. In all instances, the Procuring Entity shall ensure that the most advantageous price for the Government is obtained.”

WHEREAS, under Section 48.3 of Rule XVI – Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the R.A. 9184 to wit:

“...If the original method of procurement recommended in the APP was competitive bidding but cannot be ultimately pursued, the BAC, through a resolution, shall justify and recommend the change in the method of procurement to be approved by the HoPE...”

WHEREAS, Sec. 52. Shopping of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the R.A. 9184 provides that Shopping is a method of procurement of Goods whereby the Procuring Entity simply request for the submission of price quotations for readily available off-the-shelf goods or ordinary/regular equipment to be procured directly from suppliers of known qualifications.

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WHEREAS, Sec. 53. Negotiated Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the R.A. 9184 provides that Negotiated Procurement is a procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting services, whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally and financially capable supplier;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend that the mode of procurement for Alternative Mode of Procurement.
